

ITR for Australia Visa — Which Tax Returns to Submit?

What an officer checks in this document — and what gets it refused.

What this document must contain

Last 3 years of ITR-V acknowledgement + full ITR forms. Download from incometax.gov.in -> 'e-Filed Returns/Forms'. Submit as color PDFs or colored photocopies. Must show the Income Tax Department's receipt stamp.

Do

- Download ITRs directly from incometax.gov.in (never edit them)
- Submit 3 consecutive recent years
- Include Form 26AS alongside ITR-V
- If you have multiple income sources, include Form 16 + Form 26AS
- For business owners, include audit reports if applicable
- Match ITR figures with bank statements and salary slips

Do not

- Don't inflate ITR income (embassies cross-verify with bank statements)
- Don't skip a year (if you didn't file, explain with letter)
- Don't submit ITR-V alone — include full form
- Don't alter the IT Dept receipt stamp
- Don't submit old/manual returns without e-verification
- Don't show inconsistent income year-over-year without explanation

Mistakes that get this document refused

- Showing huge income jumps (Rs. 3 lakh -> Rs. 15 lakh in one year raises red flags)
- ITR income doesn't match bank salary credits
- Missing recent filing (current year not yet filed)
- Submitting only ITR-V without full form
- Self-employed applicants without business proof
